<p>There are no skating privileges associated with Sustaining Membership except for CFSC Professionals and Alumni classification. To qualify for Alumni classification a member must have previously had a Home Club Membership with Chaska FSC and be approved by the Board of Directors. Alumni will have limited skating privileges of buying on to club sessions - not to exceed 15 skating sessions during the regular skating season.</p>
